## Release eo2024.14 Summary:

Release eo2024.14 is scheduled to be deployed beginning at 6:00 p.m. ET on Wednesday, October 30, 2024. This release includes a variety of very minor bug fixes as described below:

### **I. BUG CORRECTION: ACDV TRANSFER PROCESS DISPLAYED EXTRA SCREEN AND COMMENT BOX IN ERROR**

We have corrected a bug that manifested when operators attempted to transfer certain ACDV records to other operators. Specifically, the application was expecting operators to re-enter certain information, including a comment, but still did not present a method to transfer the record. We have corrected that behavior, eliminating the additional screen and comment box, and allowing the record to be transferred.

### **II. BUG CORRECTION: DATA FURNISHER WAS REQUIRED TO RE-ENTER PAYMENT HISTORY GRID VALUES ON CERTAIN REINSERTION REQUESTS**

We have fixed an issue that prevented Data Furnishers from correcting certain invalid values within the Payment History Grid on Reinsertion Requests. DFs were required to clear and then re-create the entire payment history before being able to submit the Reinsertion. We have corrected this behavior, thus allowing Data Furnishers to update the invalid values directly within the Payment History Grid.

### **III. BUG CORRECTION: CERTAIN FIELDS WERE AUTOMATICALLY DESELECTING WHEN AN OPERATOR CLICKED IN BLANK SPACE ON THE OPERATOR PROFILE CHANGES REPORT**

Operators have the capability to select fields to be displayed within the Operator Profile Changes Report. This bug fix corrects an issue that inadvertently caused some of the selected fields to be deselected and not displayed in the report when an operator clicked in blank space above the report within e-OSCAR.
